Feeding Directions: *Everyday Low Starch Horse Pellet* is a lower protein, high fat pellet containing a higher fermentable fiber with lower starch and sugar levels. *Everyday Low Starch* may be fed to many types of horses and different feeding programs.

Adult Horses	lbs Low Starch/100 lbs Body Wght.
MAINT	0.40 – 0.70
LIGHT WORK	0.50 – 0.80
MED WORK	0.60 – 0.95
HEAVY WORK	0.70 – 1.10

Breeding Horses	
MARE – last 3 mos. of pregnancy	0.50 – 0.70
STALLION	0.50 – 0.70

Other	
STARCH/SUGAR SENSITIVE	0.50 – 1.25

Adjust the feeding of *Everyday Low Starch* depending on the condition of the horse. Provide horses with good quality hay or pasture and salt free choice. *Always provide plenty of fresh clean water.*

Everyday Low Starch may be fed in conjunction with other *Everyday Horse Feeds*.

Other Information:

- Starch level is less than 12.00%.
- 6% Fat increases the energy density of the ration and efficiency of digestion.
- Vegetable oil helps improve skin, hair condition and appearance.
- Fiber - highly fermentable fiber sources help promote good digestion.
- Added Lysine and Methionine aid in growth and muscle tissue rebuilding.
- Improved Vitamin mineral package to meet the horse's needs.
- Yeast Culture helps keep the microbial population at healthy levels for efficiency of digestion.

Together with good quality grass hay or pasture, *Everyday Low Starch* can replace a portion of a horse's daily hay intake.

The suggested feeding program is for use as a guide only.

The animal's requirements may change due to breed, environment and management.
